



TIMBERLINE MIDDLE SCHOOL ANNUAL YEARLY PROGRESS

We are very pleased to announce that Timberline has once again met AYP as established by No Child Left Behind.

Each May, students participate in Criterion References Tests. These assessments are used to determine a student's progress and are also used to help determine Annual Yearly Progress (AYP). NCLB requires that each State establish a measurable goal in the area of Language Arts and Math. As a school, students must show mastery or near mastery of the given subject as outlined in the state core objectives.

In addition to the overall school achieving mastery, student achievement must also be measured in sub-groups. These sub-groups include ethnic groups, language groups and students with disabilities. If each sub-group does not show adequate progress, then the entire school will not receive a passing grade in AYP. The desired goal of NCLB is that schools will show yearly progress in all areas of the school.

We usually report on the UPASS determination but there are no UPASS scores this year due to the budget cuts made by the State of Utah.
