


## **PROGRAMS AT TIMBERLINE**

- •One of our goals this year is to help our 9<sup>th</sup> grade students enter High School with the credit they need to continue on to graduation. **100% Qualified** closely watches student's grades, and involves the student's parents, counselors, and administration to help students receive 100% of their credits.
- •To encourage high achievement and participation in the school, we are starting a new student incentive program entitled "Grizzly Pride". Each term students can qualify for one of three cards that they can use to receive incentives based on their level of achievement. See website for more detail.
- •To assist our new 7<sup>th</sup> Grade students transition from Elementary to Middle School, 26 ninth grade students were chosen as mentors and members of **SOAR**-Students Offering Assistance and Reassurance. These students, who are excellent students themselves, receive training from our counselors and administration then spend two days a week coaching our 7<sup>th</sup> grade students during SSR on how to be successful at TMS.
- •Every student at TMS has 30 minutes
  Tuesday –Friday to read silently, work on
  homework, or attend ZAP- Zeros Aren't
  Permitted program which allows students,
  referred by their teacher, to work with a
  teacher to complete their assignments. Thus
  far this year, students have attended ZAP
  1681 times and completed 1229 assignments.
