Concurrent Enrollment Classes are for Juniors and Seniors.

Sophomores may take Concurrent Enrollment classes with approval from UVU's Concurrent Enrollment department. To be considered as a student, Sophomores must turn in 1) a UVU Concurrent Enrollment Exception Form 2) high school transcript and 3) test scores from an Aspire, EXLPLORE, PLAN, Pre-ACT, ACT or ACT-R score sheet. This application can be turned into Charlotte Elsey (Room 120), Camiel Fairbanks (Room 129) or UVU's Concurrent Enrollment Department.

UVU will register all Sophomores. Sophomores cannot register themselves.

If a student drops one of these classes, they MUST NOTIFY the PG Concurrent Enrollment Coordinator, Charlotte Elsey, immediately, or they will receive a UW (F) on their college transcript, if not properly dropped from the course.

Concurrent Enrollment courses give you high school and college credit at the same time. Students receive the credit/grades at the end of the school year for the year-long classes. Grades for semester classes are received at the end of each semester. Grades earned will show on the high school report cards **and will also generate an official**
